Class 2b Cannington Bio Energy 40cm Open - Qualifier for pony club mini champs

Class 3: Cannington Bio Energy 50cm Open - Qualifier for pony club mini champs

Class 4: Yeoman Haylage 60cm Open – Qualifier for pony club mini champs, Cricklands Qualifier

Class 5: Evolution Vets 70cm Open – Cricklands Qualifier

Rules

1. This competition will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2019. The judge's decision will be final.
2. Start times will be issued for each rider in each class. These may alter on day depending on how fast classes run. Please be prepared to start earlier or later than set time.
3. No rider may ride more than one horse/pony in any one team. No horse/pony can be ridden in more than two classes.
4. Teams must present themselves for tack inspection a minimum of 15 minutes before they jump. It is the responsibility of the Team Manager to familiarise the competitors with the correct turnout requirements.
5. Correct protective helmets must be worn comply with the 2019 Pony Club rules which can be found at: <https://branches.pcuk.org/quantock/files/2019/01/Hat-Rule-2019.pdf> Failure to comply will result in elimination.
6. The wearing of body protectors is recommended.
7. The warm up arena will be stewarded and numbers will be limited for safety
8. The jumps in the warm up arena must not exceed the height of the jumps in the main ring.
9. The organisers reserve the right to alter/cancel classes at their discretion. Also change start times. Please be prepared and allow enough time for classes to run early or late.
10. Late changes/additions to entries will be accepted at the organiser's discretion.
11. Liability: Neither the landowners, organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
12. The organiser of the Event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all the Officials and Stewards.
13. Dogs must preferably be left at home. Those that have to be brought to the event must be kept on leads at all times.
14. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PONY

Flu Vaccine rules for Cannington:

We will be checking vaccinations on arrival, please bring your passport to the show secretary before you unload your horse/pony.

Due to the increase in the number of reported cases of Equine Flu via the BEF & AHT we will be implementing the "within the last 6- month booster" as mandatory for all horses entering Cannington Equestrian Centre until further notice.

Any horse coming in to Cannington Equestrian Centre must have had its booster or have been vaccinated in the last 6 months. (As all of our horses have been). Please note you MUST also leave 7 days after any Flu vaccine before being allowed on site.

We also request that people continue to comply with the BEF advice that you MUST NOT take your horse to an event or competition if your horse is unwell. It's essential that any horses showing signs of possible equine flu, or horses that might have been in contact with possibly infected horses, do not travel to competitions or other events where there will be groups of horses. If your horse has been in contact with an infected horse we suggest that you should take veterinary advice.
