Each month on a **Wednesday evening, 6pm - 8pm**, we will be focusing on horse care in the following categories About the Horse: Knowing Your Horse, Handling Your Horse, Caring for Your Horse and Lungeing Your Horse, as well as Riding Fit from the riding section. (**£12 per person per evening**).

While there will be some classroom-based activities, we will also be out with the horses on the yard in order to obtain the practical skills.

You won't just learn the theory, but also gain experience in checking the fit of your horse's tack, finding his pulse, lungeing your horse and much more.

You do not need to be a BHS member to attend. However, to receive free learning resources and gain certificates for the Challenge Awards you will need to join the British Horse Society as a Silver or Gold member.

There are three levels of awards: Bronze, Silver and Gold, in different aspects of horse care and riding. You can just study your own area of interest or work towards all units and levels. This would gain you entry into further BHS assessments once you have obtained the Silver Award.
